2021 Healing Art Exhibition

The University of Central Florida, Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) and The School of Visual Arts and Design (SVAD) announce the **Healing Art Exhibition**: an annual two-dimensional art exhibition featuring works by UCF students, faculty, staff, and alumni. Selected artwork will be exhibited in Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) from January 2021 through November 2021.

Our mission is to continue to make UCF an inclusive community by focusing on CREED values which include: Integrity, Scholarship, Community, Creativity, and Excellence. The UCF Healing Art Exhibition is designed to create campus wide awareness of Counseling & Psychological Services, increase inclusivity across campus, reduce mental health stigma and create an open exhibition space for creativity and healing.

2021 Theme: *The Art of Being Visible: Expressions of Social Justice*

**We reserve the right to refuse any entries that are deemed inappropriate (ie: violent themes) due to nature of location.*

Eligibility

All entries must be original works of art, created within the past 3 years and artists must identify as student, faculty, staff member, or alumni.

Rules of Entry

1. There is no entry fee.
2. The maximum number of submissions is three.
3. Two-dimensional work in all media, including, but not limited to: Drawing, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Mixed Media, Collage, and Computer-generated imagery.
4. Size is limited to 36 inches any direction, including frame.
5. Artists must complete application form (link is posted on our website under apply, <http://caps.sdes.ucf.edu/art/apply>)
6. Artists must electronically attach digital images that accurately represent the creative work for the jury process (link is posted on our website: <http://caps.sdes.ucf.edu/art/apply>).
7. Digital images must be JPEG and a minimum of 75 dpi.
8. Each digital file must be named accordingly: The artist's first initial, last name and item number as reflected on the Entry Information Form. Example: John Doe= JDoe1, JDoe2, JDoe3).
9. Do not mail or deliver original artwork for the jury process.
10. Artists must include measurements of each submission on the application form.

11. Artist's completed application, including paperwork and digital files, must be received by midnight, Friday, November 6th, 2020
12. Artwork will then be viewed by a CAPS committee and go through a selection process. If accepted, artists will be informed
13. Artists must drop off artwork ready to hang (framing, matting, etc.).
Drop off dates are Thursday, Nov 19th and Friday, November 20th, 2020. **Specific times will be e-mailed.**
14. Artwork pick-up will be November 2021.
15. In the event that the artwork is not picked up by November 13th, 2020, UCF Counseling & Psychological Services (CAPS) will consider the work to have been abandoned. CAPS will make effort to get in touch with the artist, and if the artist does not respond in a timely way, work will become the property of CAPS to be used as it deems appropriate.
16. CAPS is not responsible for lost, stolen, or misdirected entries.
17. Your entry acknowledges acceptance of the rules of entry.
18. To guarantee client confidentiality, the exhibition is only open to the public during the opening reception in February 2021 and at scheduled viewings. Opening reception will be open to family, friends, and community. More information provided at later date.

Criteria and Judging

The panel of judges will be professional art educators, practicing artists, a representative from SDES, and a University representative. Works will be selected on the basis of original concept, expressive use of media, artistic excellence, and representation of theme.
